OECD iLibrary is the OECD's new online library for books, papers and statistics, and the gateway to OECD's analysis and data. It enables users to identify global economic trends and to measure one country's performance against others. As one of the most comprehensive online resources for data and analysis on the world economy, OECD iLibrary is a powerful tool for researchers at academic institutions, in the private sector and at governmental and non-governmental organisations.

## **2. What is OECD iLibrary?**

All OECD's publications and databases are now available on the new online platform OECD iLibrary, launched in 2010.

This outstanding resource for the world economy provides online access to the following:

- 500 issues
- 1,200 articles

- 25,000 Excel files accessible from the full-text of publications (“StatLink” files)
- 5,000 Excel files directly accessible from search or navigation

Interactive statistical databases

- 300 datasets
- 4 billion data points

OECD iLibrary incorporates all the latest technology so as to simplify search and discovery for users, and make users more productive. The torrent of content being added to the internet each day makes users less and less productive as they waste time searching for content they can trust. Their productivity can also be improved if the content they find has embedded services which allow them to re-use it. An example of this is OECD’s StatLink service, which allows users to download charts and tables in Excel.

OECD iLibrary also incorporates other productivity-enhancing features such as a citation tool, reference linking, RSS feeds, email alerts, permanent links for easy bookmarking and DOIs for optimal citation. OpenURL compliancy, federated searching (Z39.50 standard) and automatic login via Athens/Shibboleth make OECD content easily accessible.

For librarians, OECD iLibrary offers a variety of features which help simplify and improve work in the library. An institutional account management function enables librarians to quickly update their institution’s details, such as adding new IP address information. COUNTER compliant usage statistics and bibliographic records in MARC21 format can also be easily accessed.

### **3. Who is OECD iLibrary useful for?**

#### **Libraries**

With OECD iLibrary, libraries offer users the best possible service and at the same time save both space and time managing subscriptions and ad hoc orders. A single subscription to OECD iLibrary gives users online access to the complete OECD archive as well as to all new publications and statistics.

#### **Universities and research organisations**

Our data and analysis help academics, researchers and students understand trends in the global economy, society and environment. OECD iLibrary enables them to keep in touch with the latest developments in their field. With access to one of the largest collections of economic data in the world, authors of scholarly works can underpin their research with the latest, most reliable (and sometimes surprising) statistics.
